The Judge, Mary Iselin, commented on the lively still life: *Subdued Nest*

"I was drawn immediately into this piece! Here so many elements are so masterfully displayed: the texture of the nest and eggs; the unusual composition; the tonal colors.

It is highly realistic, but still calls attention to the medium in a marvelously painterly way.

It is uncommon for a "still life" to move so dramatically. I felt that the nest is both complete unto itself, and,at the same time, so vulnerable to the elements! Beautiful rendering." **Terri Brooks** has three pieces, two pastels in an upcoming show, Strong Women Move Mountains at the Pace Gallery in Fryeburg.
