PSME Excellence in Education - Young Adult Scholarship

The PSME Excellence in Education Scholarship will be awarded in June, at the Kennebunk High School's Annual Award Ceremony. The award will be presented to a graduating senior planning to continue their art studies at the college level.

PSME provides \$500, issued through two checks. One check is to be used for summer art classes and the other check for second-semester college expenses. In addition to the monetary award professional materials will be donated by the scholarship's founder. This year's scholarship includes a Unison 63 half-stick pastel set, Rembrandt 30 half-stick pastel set, 24 Art Spectrum pastel sticks, Nupastels 12 stick pastel set, Carb-Othello 12 pastel pencil set, sketchbook, miscellaneous pastel papers and boards, and a copy of *Pastel Pointers* by Richard McKinley. The scholarship is valued at approximately \$1,000.00. This year's scholarship recipient will be announced in the next newsletter.

PSME Educational Meeting

Developing Realistic Textures in Pastel Paintings

Owls Head pastel artist Nancy Lee Lovley was the presenter at the April PSME educational meeting at the Curtis Memorial Library on 23 Pleasant Street in Brunswick.

Nancy is a lifelong artist who began painting with pastels as a pre-teen. Nancy paints wonderfully realistic textures in her work.

She brought four of her completed paintings, to demonstrate how she achieves realistic texture in four different subjects.

Nancy works almost exclusively on the 'smooth' side of Canson Paper not sanded paper. The paper is mounted onto adhesive board. Much of her painting time is spent creating a detailed drawing often making use of a graph. The subject matter is copied onto the graph from a photograph. Backgrounds are painted with pan pastels and the painting continues with hard pastels first and continuing with softer pastels as needed.

She is especially well known for her still life and her portraiture of people and animals in the classical realism style. Nancy's preferred teaching style is to work while answering questions from her audience. This audience provided interesting questions and commentary. A worthwhile and informative educational experience was achieved.

The reception is being held on June 24th 2 to 4pm .


